

# 2018 Capital Dragon Boat Regatta at The WHARF

## RACE TEAM REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Each team should consist of 20 paddlers, 1 drummer and up to 4 alternates. NO EXPERIENCE REQUIRED. Team members must be at least 12 years of age as of the time of the festival. Teams must have a minimum of 8 male and 8 female paddlers in order to qualify as a mixed boat. For a Women's/BCS team, the drummer must be female, but the steerer may be any gender.

Paddlers may race for only a single mixed team; however paddlers racing on a mixed team may also race as part of 1 additional open, women's, or BCS team. Racers double roster at their own peril, no boats will be held at the dock waiting for paddlers on the water. This will be strictly enforced in 2018.

The following is the fee schedule for the Capital Dragon Boat Regatta.

Community team registration fees include two training sessions. Teams may request additional training sessions at the rate of \$75 per session, pending availability.
